## Bible Study 3 - Cain and Abel

### Genesis 4:1 – 4:25 (Read from the International Children's Version)

1. Have you ever been so angry with someone that you wanted to hurt them?
2. Why do you think you wanted to do that?
3. What do you do when you get angry?
4. Who are the main characters in this story?
5. Who do you think Cain was mad at? Abel.
6. Do you think he was mad at anyone else? Yes, God.
7. Who do you think he was mad at the most—God or Abel? God.
8. Why do you think he took out his anger on Abel?
9. Have you ever become angry with someone (like mom or dad) and took it out on someone else (brother or sister).
10. Why did you do it? Because you can't get mad at mom and dad.
11. What started all of this anger in the first place—who did what?
12. What was it that God was not pleased with?
13. Do you think it was the fruit that Cain brought that was rotten, or his attitude?
14. Why did God like Abel's sacrifice?
15. Do you think God loved Abel better than Cain? No, but God doesn't put up with bad attitudes.
16. What did God ask Cain to do to be accepted? Do what is right.
17. What is crouched down hiding, just waiting to get you when you do wrong? Sin.
18. What did God tell Cain that he had to "master"? Sin.
19. What should you do when you get angry? Love instead. Be an answer--not a problem.
20. Pray for God to help the children with their times of anger.
