11. How did the people treat Noah while he built his Ark? How do you think that made Noah feel?
12. What sign did God give Noah to show that He would never completely destroy everything with a flood again?
13. Does this mean God will never destroy the earth again? (No)
14. What do you think Noah did with the fish? (He didn't take the fish!)
15. What do you think Noah did all that time in the Ark?
16. What do you do on rainy days?
17. What was the longest that you ever had to wait on something? (To be finished, to come, to change, happen, etc.) For what? Was it worth it?
