Bible Study 7 – Abram and Lot

Genesis 13:1 - 18 (Read from the International Children's Version)

1. Have you ever gave something up for somebody else, or didn't do something so somebody else could do it?
2. Abram was Lot's uncle. What problem did they have? (Too much of everything)
3. How do you think they got all of that stuff? (The Lord blessed them)
4. What did they do to fix their problem? (They decided to separate)
5. When Abram and Lot separated, one of them was greedy. Which one? (Lot)
6. Abram gave Lot a choice. What was it? (Any part of the land he wanted)
7. When Lot made his choice, do you think he took what looked best to him? (Yes)
8. Since Abram was his uncle, why do you think he gave Lot the first pick instead of taking it for himself? (He loved Lot, just like God loved Abram, and wanted to give like God gives)
9. Abram seemed stuck with the land that was not as good. Since Abram was generous and kind, what did God do to reward Him? (He gave him even more land, and promised to make him a father of many)
10. How many children did God promise to Abram? (They would be like all of the dust)
11. In the end, who did God bless more? (Abram)
12. When your parents give you a choice—say like between a big candy bar and a small one—do you always take the big one and leave them with the small one?
13. When you show kindness by taking a smaller thing and leaving the other person with the big thing, how does that make you feel?
14. Do you think God will reward you for your kindness just like he did Abram?
15. What is something nice that you could do for your mom or dad?
